Tsal'alh Chief Ida Mary Peter Report to the Community – from June 24, 2019

- 1) SCC Mtg May 1, 2019
 - A) SCC strategic planning: July 22 – 23, 2019
 - Alignment of Nation Level Organizations (SGS, SER, STP)
 - Assertion of Territorial Integrity
 - B) St'at'imc Policy Advisor Report:
 - St'at'imc / Tsilhqot'in MOU
 - Fish Lake, St'at'imc Chiefs Council provided support letter to Tsilhqot'in, to halt all drilling and exploration in Fish Lake.
 - -West Fraser and Tolko Forest Companies: Concerns about forest harvesting in the northern part of our nation.
 - -SER: interim board is to review governance documents and align with SCC governance.
 - -Water License – BCH: BCH wants to apply for water license in perpetuity, and is in the process for licenses through the Water Comptroller. On March 21st, 2019 SCC sent a letter to Ted White, the Water Comptroller expressing our issues and concerns, as well requesting a meeting. We have not received a reply yet.
 - C) SCC Secretariat Report: Request for SCC office space at LTC office, to move SCC staff from SGS to LTC
 - D) St'at'imc Political meeting on Title, Nation Re-building, Working Together and Development of a Title-Focused Nation Group.
- 2) 2) LTC Chiefs Meeting June 7, 2019
 - A) Fishing news, Mid – August sockeye salmon stock may be good. Weather dependant, and water temperature.
 - B) ISETS: LTC will be primarily responsible for planning, research and coordinating implementation of these objectives. To begin delivery of ISET services in April 2020, to successfully negotiate a disentanglement agreement with the Shuswap Nation Tribal Council, to have a minimum of two certified Career Development Practitioners in place before April 2020. LTC Chiefs supported a May 2019 submission to negotiate a Labour Market Master Agreement.
 - C) Child and Families Updates (Kanuk'wastaliha Family Services) Looking to start a Grandmother's Declaration group for (the safety, well being and identity of children and families as a priority). Strategic Planning and Goals 2019 for Family preservation they have identified (short, mid-term and long -term goals).

Hello Band Membership on and off reserve,

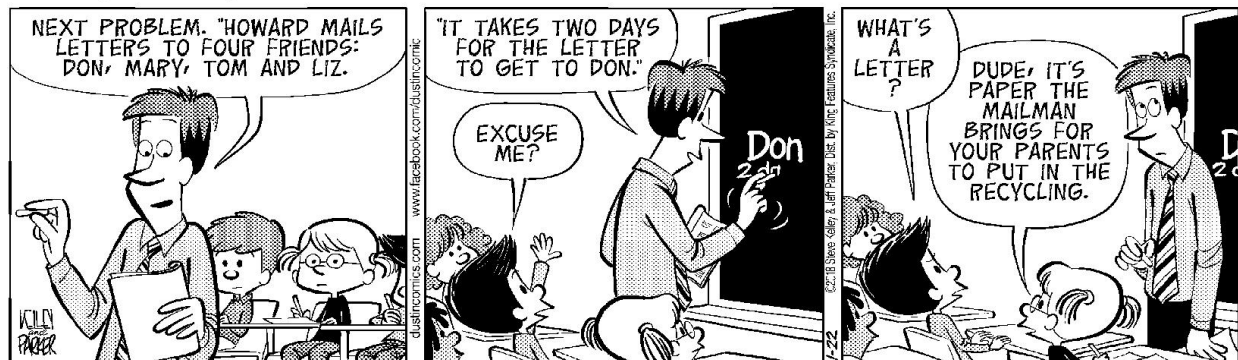
